



UNSPSC Commodity Codeset Being Utilized in MissouriBUYS

The State of Missouri is utilizing Version 17 of the UNSPSC commodity/service code set in MissouriBUYS.

Please note that the UNSPSC website (<http://www.unspsc.org>) has a newer version of the UNPSC commodity code set posted on their website (i.e. Version 20). This means that any codes found when conducting a search on the UNSPSC website may not be available for selection in MissouriBUYS since the State of Missouri's eProcurement system uses Version 17.

The UNSPSC commodity/service code set has a hierarchical structure that includes the following four levels: segment (2 digits), family (4 digits), class (6 digits), and commodity (8 digits).

When registering as a vendor, the user can search and select applicable UNSPSC commodity/service code(s) during the registration process in MissouriBUYS. Missouri requires at least one UNSPSC code be selected in order to become an approved vendor in MissouriBUYS. Once registered, a vendor can go into MissouriBUYS and edit their profile to add or edit the UNSPSC commodity code(s) associated with their organization.
